## Swiss Brain League research prize

In 2026, the Swiss Brain League will award a **sponsorship prize** of **CHF 40,000** to a Swiss research group for outstanding scientific achievement in the field of brain research. This year, the prize will be awarded to clinical or translational neuroscientific research, of which scientific investigations on patients form an important part. The prize will generally be given to the working group *as a whole* that contributes to a scientific achievement.

The prerequisite is that the research has been published <u>as a single publication</u> in the two years prior to the call for applications or has been accepted for <u>publication</u> by an internationally recognized journal. The research must also have been conducted primarily at Swiss clinics and/or institutions.

Applications are to be submitted electronically (Word or PDF format) along with the scientific publication and declaration of intent explaining how the prize money will be used, a brief CV with a list of publications for each researcher, and an informed consent declaration signed by the authors. Applications must be **submitted via email** (info@hirnliga.ch) **by September 30, 2025.**
